Working in partnership

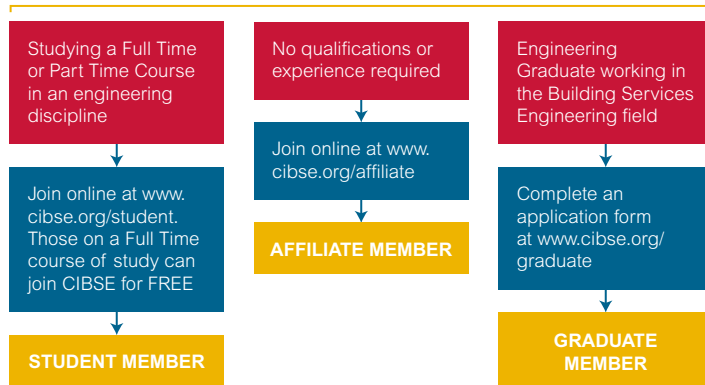

CIBSE ANZ also works in association with the Society of Building Services Engineers in promoting monthly technical meetings.

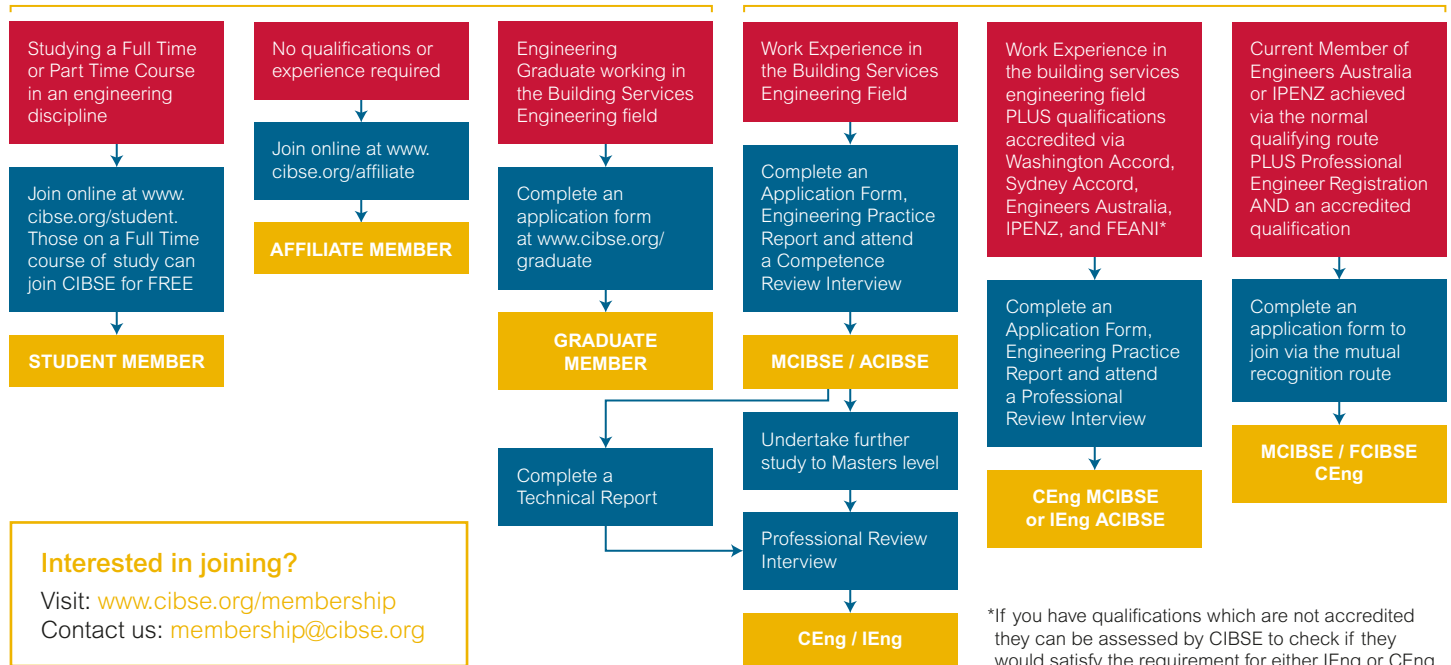
Joining CIBSE
